#### First month of school

As we completed our first successful month, we are proud to share the areas that we focused on these three weeks on getting the children to know their school and classroom routine. They are also learning how to interact with their peers. We also focused on cooperation, sharing and helping others.

Our theme was "All about me". The first week we learned about the "Golden rules" followed by "Emotions". We also learned about the "Good touch and Bad touch" in detail with role play and puppet show. Numeracy- We focused on Numbers from 1 to 10 with various activities like sequential counting, Number hopscotch, games etc. Recognition of numbers 1 to 5 is done on a daily basis. We also sang shape rhymes and number rhymes during circle time.

Literacy- We started our first group of Jolly phonics by introducing letters s,a,t,i with the phonic sounds and actions. Also we watched videos of Jolly phonics. Story time was done on daily basis and we learned lot of new vocabulary during this month. Children look forward to coming to school because they are excited for the extra-curricular activities every day.

## I-Spy Science

A science fair was conducted on the 27th of July, at Nalapad Academy, to show the children how science can be fun. Interactive scientific experiments and displays taught the kids various concepts in science, right from magnets to robotics. Children learnt about density of fluids, how magnets work, and what non- Newtonian fluids are. They were excited to make their own slime, kaleidoscope, and even their own rocket piggy-bank. Overall, the science fair was a fun learning experience for the children and their parents.

#### PRE-ASSESSMENTS




